

AN ORDINANCE

of the Borough of West Kittanning, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, relating to the prohibition of parking vehicles upon or otherwise obstructing a portion of Harrison Street in said Borough, and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

The Council of the Borough of West Kittanning ordains as follows:-

§1. From and after the passage and promulgation of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle upon, or otherwise obstruct, any part of the paved portion of Harrison Street between its intersection with Cleveland Street and a point three hundred and fifty (350) feet in a southerly direction therefrom.

§2. Proper official signs notifying of the foregoing restrictions shall be erected along the affected portion of Harrison Street.

§3. Any person violating the provisions hereof, upon conviction before the Burgess or a Justice of the Peace for the Borough shall be fined not more than ten (10) nor less than five (5) dollars for each offense, together with the costs of prosecution, and upon default made in the payment thereof may be committed to the County Jail one (1) day for each five (5) dollars of fine and costs imposed, not to exceed five (5) days.
