

WEST KITTANNING BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 78

An ordinance laying out, opening and adopting as a public street in the Borough of West Kittanning, streets and parts of streets to be designated as a portion of North Crescent Drive, a portion of Residential Avenue, and Garfield Street Extension, and fixing and regulating the widths and grades thereof.

The Borough of West Kittanning hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION ONE: The following street, which is designated as a portion of North Crescent Drive, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street of the width of forty (40) feet in the Borough of West Kittanning: the center line of said street beginning at a point in the intersection of Arthur Street and the existing North Crescent Drive, as shown on plan of R. B. Shannon & Associates, dated August, 1965; thence in a northerly and westerly direction by a curve to the right having a radius of ~~720.37~~ feet, a distance of 98.30 feet; thence continuing to the North and West by a curve to the right with a radius of 370.00 feet, a distance of 294.30 feet to a point in the center of the portion of Residential Drive hereinafter ordained, being of a total length along the center line of 392.60 feet.

SECTION TWO: The grade of said portion of North Crescent Drive, beginning in Arthur Street, as aforesaid, and proceeding northwesterly direction along the center line thereof for a distance of 150 feet shall be a descending grade of one and two tenths (1.2%) per centum and from such point by a verticle curve a distance of 50 feet to a point and from such point, con-

tinuing along the center line for a distance of 192.60 feet to the center of Residential Avenue as aforesaid, the grade shall be an ascending grade of two and six tenths (2.6%) per centum. The slope on said street shall be one-quarter inch ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") per foot.

SECTION THREE: The following street, which is designated as a portion of Residential Avenue, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street of the width of forty (40) feet in the Borough of West Kittanning:

The center line of said street, beginning at a point in the intersection of Arthur Street and the existing Residential Avenue, as shown on plan of R. B. Shannon & Associates, dated August, 1965; thence South $88^{\circ} 09' 30''$ West a distance of 385 feet to a point in the center line of Garfield Street Extension, hereinafter ordained.

SECTION FOUR: The grade of said portion of Residential Avenue, beginning in Arthur Street as aforesaid, and proceeding South $88^{\circ} 09' 30''$ West along the center line thereof, shall be an ascending grade of eight tenths of one per centum ($\frac{8}{10}\%$) for the entire 385 feet of this extension of Residential Avenue. The slope on said street shall be one-quarter inch ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") per foot.

SECTION FIVE: The following street, which is designated as Garfield Street Extension, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street of the width of forty (40) feet in the Borough of West Kittanning:

The center line of said street, beginning at the terminus of the center line of Residential Avenue as described in Section Three of this Ordinance, and as shown on plan of R. B.

Shannon & Associates, dated August, 1965; thence North 1° 50' 30" West, a distance of two hundred ninety-seven and seventeen one-hundredths feet (297.17) to the intersection of the center lines of First Avenue and Garfield Streets.

SECTION SIX: The grade of Garfield Street Extension beginning at the center line of Residential Avenue, as aforesaid, and proceeding North 1° 50' 30" West, along the center line thereof, shall be an ascending grade of two and nine-tenths (2.9%) per centum for the entire 297.17 feet thereof. The slope on said street shall be one-quarter inch ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") per foot.
