

ORDINANCE NO. Page 36, 1958.

AN ORDINANCE regulating and restricting outdoor fires within the Borough of West Kittanning, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof.

The Borough of West Kittanning hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. No person or persons shall set or maintain any fire upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys or public grounds of the Borough of West Kittanning, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, or burn or cause to be burned thereon any paper, boxes, rubbish, leaves, or other material or substance of any kind, nor shall any person or persons set or maintain any fire or burn or cause to be burned any substance or material of any kind out-of-doors anywhere within the limits of the said Borough as now or hereafter, as the case may be.

Section 2. Out-of-doors fires shall be permitted upon private property in the said Borough, provided that the following regulations and restrictions are strictly adhered to:

Every such out-of-door fire shall be built in and confined to a non-combustible container, covered with a screen of one-half (1/2) inch mesh or with other suitable non-combustible material.

No such fire shall be closer than fifteen (15) feet to any building or any property line.

No such fire shall be allowed to burn upon any day except between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M.

Section 3. Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars, and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.
