

AN ORDINANCE prescribing traffic regulations and providing penalties for their violation in the Borough of West Kittanning, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania.

The Borough of West Kittanning hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Words and phrases when used in this ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, as now in force or as hereafter amended, enacted or re-enacted, except in those instances where the context clearly indicates a different meaning. The singular shall include the plural, and the masculine shall include the feminine.

Section 2. The speed limit on U. S. Route No. 422, from the eastern boundary of West Kittanning Borough where West Kittanning Borough bounds North Buffalo Township, thence in a westerly direction to the westerly boundary of West Kittanning Borough and East Franklin Township line, shall be 35 miles per hour.

Section 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$10.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than 10 days.


