

ORDINANCE NO. 89

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CURFEW REGULATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH MINORS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Borough of West Kittanning, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1: Curfew

(a) No child under the age of sixteen years shall loiter on the streets or elsewhere out of doors in the Borough, in the night season unless accompanied by a parent or other adult guardian or having a newly-written signed and dated statement from such parent or guardian that such child is on an emergency errand.

(b) Any child found after the time appointed shall be warned by any policemen to go home, and if after such warning the child is found loitering on the streets, such child may be taken by such policeman to his home.

(c) No parent or guardian shall permit his child or ward to habitually violate this section, after having been warned in writing.

Section 2: Penalty

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this article, unless otherwise provided, shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and, in default of the payment thereof, may be imprisoned in the County Jail for not more than thirty days.
