ORDINANCE NO. 93-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF THE
GENERAL ORDINANCE OF AUGUST 15, 1900 AND
PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OF THE
DISCHARGE OF EXPLOSIVES AND FIREARMS WITHIN
THE BOROUGH OF WEST KITTANNING.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of West
Kittanning and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of
same as follows:

Section 3.a. No person shall fire or cause to be fired
within the Borough of West Kittanning any fire cracker, squibs,
fire works or any other explosive or kindle any bonfire in any
public street or alley or, except in the legal and necessary
defense of life or property, fire or discharge any gun, air
rifle, pellet or firearm within the Borough of West Kittanning.

Section 3.b. All persons who violate this section shall
for each and every violation, upon conviction thereof, be
subject to a penalty as imposed by a district justice of not
more than \$300.00 or less than \$50.00 plus costs of prosecution
and in default of payment, imprisonment of not more than thirty
(30) days.

In all other aspects the General Ordinance of August 15, 1900 shall remain in full force and effect.
