

THE BOROUGH OF WEST KITTANNING

ORDINANCE NO. PAGE 46

An ordinance prescribing traffic and parking regulations and providing penalties for their violation.

The Borough of West Kittanning, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:-

Article I. Stop Intersections.

The following intersections in the borough are hereby declared to be stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected in such a position as to face traffic approaching the second named street in the direction or directions hereby indicated. All vehicles approaching the intersection upon the first named street in the direction or directions hereby indicated in each case shall come to a full stop, within a reasonable distance, before entering said intersection:

1. Intersection of First Avenue and Arthur Street.
2. Intersection of Arthur Street and First Avenue.
3. Intersection of Southern Avenue and Arthur Street.
4. Intersection of Arthur Street and Southern Avenue.

Article II. Parking Prohibited.

Parking shall be prohibited at the following times and at the following places:

1. In front of or beside the public school property, on the east side of Arthur Street and on the north side of Southern Avenue, between the hours of eight o'clock ante meridian and six o'clock post meridian each day that school shall be in session.

Article III. Penalties.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of Article I or Article II of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5.00) or more than ten dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, shall be committed to the county jail for not more than five (5) days.


